Teams: To comprise teams of 3 or 4 riders jumping in the same class.

Each team member will automatically be entered as an individual as well as part of a team in that class.

Best 3 scores in the team to count.

Competitors will only jump their class round and the score will count for both team and individual entry.

Class 1: 0.70m Jumping (inc Team jumping)

Sect A: Open, Sect B: Riders over 40 years of age.

Horse/rider combinations entering this class may not enter classes 4, 5 or 6.

Class 2: 0.75m Jumping (inc Team jumping)

Sect A: Open, Sect B: Riders over 40 years of age

Class 3: 0.85m Jumping (inc Team jumping)

Sect A: Open, Sect B: Riders over 40 years of age

Class 4: 0.90m Open Jumping (inc Team jumping)

Class 5: 1.0m Open Jumping (inc Team jumping)

Class 6: 1.05m Open Jumping (inc Team jumping)

All classes will be run as Two Phase

AWARDS

Rosettes will be given to sixth place for individuals.

Medals to individual riders placed 1st to 3rd in each class.

Rosettes will be given to fourth place in each class for teams.

A BEST MEMBER rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Meon member in each class/section.

ENTRY FEES:

MRC members	- £12 per class
Non-members	- £14 per class
MRC Teams	Say if you are in a team and give team name (very important)
Late Entries	- £2 extra per person

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, the landowner and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies howsoever caused on the premises.
- 2 These competitions will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rulebook 2017. All classes will be run as two phase.
- 3 Competitors who are not British Riding Club members should carry their own Third Party Liability insurance.
- 4 Riders who fall must retire from that class and leave the arena dismounted. They may compete in subsequent classes unless advised not to do so by First Aid officials
- 5 Protective Headwear' must be worn at all times when mounted, with harness correctly adjusted and fastened. 'BRC Rulebook 2017 recommends that Protective Headwear should meet one of the following standards:

British	PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked
European	VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked
American	ASTM F1163; 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001 or SNELL 2016
Australian & New Zealand	AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked

- 6 The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the said offence to the show organisers accompanied by a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld
- 7 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or alter classes. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be made less £3 per entry form to cover administration costs.
- 8 No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate and a stamped self-addressed envelope sent to the entries secretary no later than 14 days after the date of the competition.
- 9 Absolutely no telephone entries.
- 10 All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- 11 No horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in any class.
- 12 No lungeing permitted.
- 13 No DOGS are allowed at Crofton Manor Equestrian Centre.
- 14 Please use the bins provided for litter
- 15 Please remove droppings etc from lorry/trailer area when you leave.
